- Identify and implement improvements to the process of collection and management of metrics necessary to efficiently report on sustainability objectives.

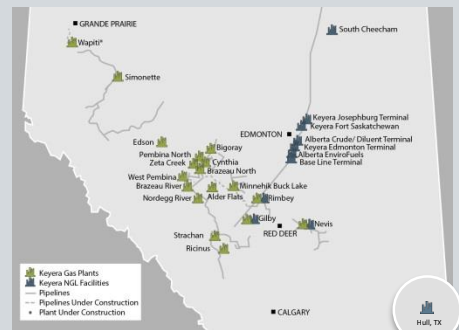
