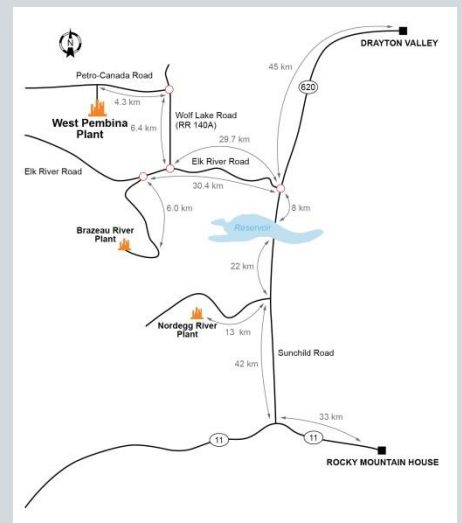
### RESPONSIBILITIES
